-Lunch Room Monitors: the schedule changed over the past year and has affected the teachers timetable. Next year, we would like to use older students to help the younger students at lunch time, teaching the younger students. A teacher will supervise more than 1 classroom because they will have older helpers in the classroom. Principal Thiesen will "train" the helpers and thank them at the end of the year. The lunch room monitors will eat their lunch while there in the younger class. He has done in previous school and it has worked well.
