Cobra Cup Tournament Rules



- Each game will consist of a 10-minute warm up, four 10 minute running time quarters with the last 1 minute of each quarter being stop time.
- Half time will be allotted 5 minutes.
- Full court press and zone defense are not allowed.
- If overtime is needed a 2-minute stop time overtime will be used. If the score is still tied then another 2-minute stop time period will be used. This pattern will continue until a winner is decided.
- Each team is guaranteed 4 games, which include 3 round robin games and a final game based on standings.
- 1st and 2nd place teams will play in the Gold Medal final and the 3rd and 4th place teams will play in the Bronze Medal final
- Standings will be based on;
 - Most wins
 - If teams tie in wins then the higher placement will be decided by the winner of the game between the tied teams, then:
 - Points for minus points against
 - Most points for
 - Least points against
 - Coin toss
- Two time outs per half. One time out during the overtime session.
- FIBA rules will be followed.
