- **Why Invest in School Council?**
 - **Positive Value.** School councils are mandated by the government as a forum for parents to be engaged in the education of the children and participate in decisions that impact student learning and success. It's an opportunity for you to add value and direction.
 - **Positive Leadership.** Being involved in school council demonstrates leadership to the students. Children learn what they see. Parents who show interest and involvement in the greater school community are modeling positive leadership skills. Being a leader doesn't mean you need to be at every meeting. Find ways to contribute your skills and time. For example, creating newsletters, encouraging teachers, administrative tasks or research.
 - **Positive Collaboration.** Investing in school council is a means to creating and maintaining a culture of respect and collaboration. It is critical for the overall health of a school to incorporate the voices of all members including students and parents.
