EXCITING CHANGESMIDDLE SCHOOL

There are some exciting changes coming to the Middle School next year! We are moving the Grade 9 core courses to a semester system and they write PATs in both January and June. The idea behind this is to have less courses to concentrate on at one time and fewer "high stakes" exams to worry about. During that time period, we will also be writing formal mid-term exams for the Grade 7&8 students to give them an opportunity to write a bigger test and receive feedback on it. As it stands, exams are written at the end of the year, and students aren't given much in the way of feedback about what they achieved and what could be improved.

We are also including "flex" periods to help students from Grade 7-9 with subject areas they are struggling with. This would be a supervised time of learning with a teacher present who will help them receive more attention (and hopefully less homework!).

We are also introducing more options for Grades 7&8 by including a drama option. Options will now be split into 4 sections for the year, with each student trying foods, shop, drama and art.

For parents of our current Grade 6 students - we are having a welcome back camp-out at the school on the evening of Thursday, August 28th. We will be inviting students to the school in the evening and having a good old fashioned camp-out in the high school soccer field. We will be playing games and having a campfire to welcome students into Grade 7 and to allow them meet some new students and new teachers. It should be a fun night of introductions and community building. Details to follow in August.

High School schedule changes can be made on Friday, August 29. Grade 10 students are welcome to come from 10-11am, Grade 11 students from 11-12pm and Grade 12 students from 12-1pm.

Current Grade 11 students – University applications open in late fall (less than six months from now!). Are you ready to decide where and what you want to study after you graduate? Are you set to take the required prerequisites? Contact Mrs. Foster if you need help preparing for the decisions ahead.

Grade 12 Transcripts - If you are planning to attend a post-secondary institution outside of Alberta this September, you need to order an official final transcript from Alberta Education. You can order it now, specifying that it be sent after your final grades are available (approximately July 16).

If you are attending a post-secondary institution in Alberta, you likely don't need to order a final transcript, as almost all Alberta institutions access transcripts directly through Apply Alberta. To see a list of schools that will access your transcript automatically, click here.
