CHRISTIAN CREDIT UNION SCHOLARSHIP

A \$750.00 scholarship will be made available annually to a graduating student from **Calgary Christian School** who best fulfills the conditions listed below.

- 1) The Applicant must be a member of Christian Credit Union on March 31st of the year of application.
- 2) Application for the scholarship will be made by the student in writing in the form of an essay/letter of approximately 300 words emphasizing the meaning of “Biblical Stewardship” and how it applies to their life. In addition, the student should provide a brief outline of their accomplishments, volunteerism, life and career goals. Letters must be addressed to “Christian Credit Union Scholarship” in care of the Principal of **Calgary Christian School** on or before April 15th. Applications must be submitted in “blind” form so that Christian Credit Union’s Scholarship Committee cannot identify the applicant. The application letters should therefore be unsigned and accompanied by a covering letter addressed to the Principal for identification purposes.
- 3) The Principal or his/her designate will assign a number to each letter and record the name and number on the list and will verify the accuracy of the facts stated in the application.
- 4) Applications will be considered from graduating Grade 12 students entering any discipline at any post-secondary institution but preference will be given to those entering business related programs.
- 5) Recommendations for candidates for the scholarship will be made by a committee consisting of the Principal of the school and the Grade 12 teachers. The teachers will submit the blind application letters to the Scholarship Committee of the Credit Union together with the list of applicants, which list will be placed in a separate, sealed envelope.
- 6) The Scholarship Committee will make the final selection of their recipients and the award will be made at the graduation ceremony. Payment will be made to the recipient only upon the recipient providing to the Credit Union the following:
 - 1) Confirmation of enrollment at a post secondary institution.
 - 2) Confirmation of payment of tuition to the institution.
