And significant improvements were made to alarm systems, wiring, and classroom storage.

First Student Banking Day is Wednesday, September 17. (The full [schedule](#) can be found on the website). Deposit envelopes are located outside the Community Relations Office at the Elementary or at the Secondary in the Business Office.

Did you know? Members of the Youth Banking Program are eligible to receive cash bonuses in addition to regular account interest. Grades 1-12 receive \$0.50 bonus for every month you deposit \$1.00 times your grade level. Also Grades 7-12 are eligible to receive a \$2.50 bonus for every month you deposit \$5.00 times your grade level.

Our school benefits when you save! Christian Credit Union will match bonuses paid to members of Youth Banking Program and donate it to our school. For every new account opened an additional \$5.00 is donated.
