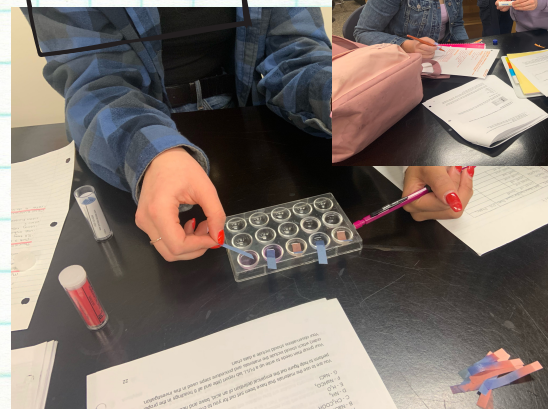
Secondary teachers have continued to offer foods and life skills options in safe ways!
