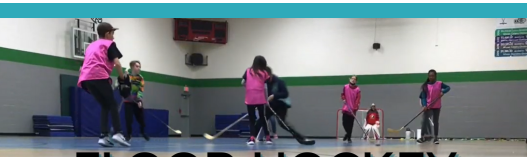
Did you know?

The CCS Maintenance team has risen to the challenges associated with running a safe and clean school environment in light of Covid19 in incredible ways. Thank you all!

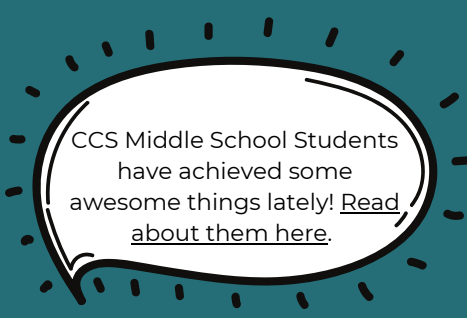
Celebrating Easter

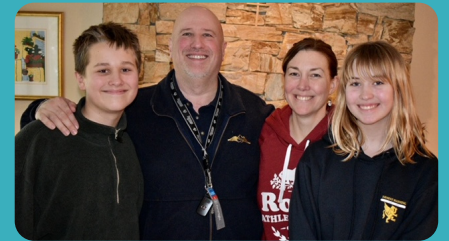
