

BOARD HIGHLIGHTS

March 2022

The meeting was called to order by the Chair. Director Michelle Zuk opened with devotions on Chronicles 15:7 "But as for you, be strong and do not give up, for your work will be rewarded." We are reminded that his verse can be a motivator during challenging and contentious times, not only in our community but around the world.

Discussion Items

- The proposed 2022-23 Budget and Long Term Financial modeling were presented based on a student population of 890.
- CCS Faith Formation Program Review (Elementary) was presented by the Executive Director highlighting the key objectives, Bible instruction, Christian Worldview Integration with the AB program of studies, *Teaching for Transformation*, and Celebration of Learning.
- Parent Listening Sessions were held with 28 participants attending. Three questions were posed each using a different method of sharing (written, "pair and share", and round the room statements) A survey focused on the process and its contact was circulated to participants afterwards. Next steps will be to report back to the board with findings and follow up with our community.
