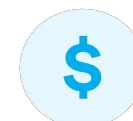

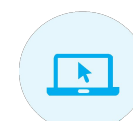

## **Payment Protection Program (Individual Coverage)**

We understand that plans can change due to unforeseen circumstances. That's why we provide the EF-exclusive Payment Protection Program.

Available at two affordable levels, in addition to the Global Travel Protection Plan individuals can add Payment Protection to their account up to 30 days after enrolment. # The small (but important) details

- You will need government issued ID's for all travellers including a passport and possible visas for international destinations
- Passports must be valid for 6 months past the date of travel
- The name of the traveller on the account needs to match ID

## Option 2: Automatic Payment Plan

Choose the payment frequency (monthly or bi-weekly) deducted from your bank account. Final payment is due 25 days prior to departure.

## Option 3: Manual Payment Plan

Receive invoices and make your payments in less frequent installments based on the date of enrolment.

## Option 4: Pay with Uplift

Book now, pay over time. Spread the cost of your trip over low monthly payments, even after you've travelled.
