Duties and Responsibilities

- Routine preventative maintenance of Plumbing, HVAC, Life Safety and oversight of other mechanical components (locks, appliances, dispensers, equipment, playgrounds etc.)

- Outdoor work (e.g. snow removal, grounds keeping)
