Secondary Expansion Project - Next Steps. The CSCE Board would like to thank those members who participated in the February 27 Resolution Meeting. They are now seeking your feedback on those results (resolution did not pass) to help determine next steps. CSCE Board Nominees and Election - "Thank you for all of the nominations for the Calgary Society for Christian Education (CSCE) Board of Directors submitted by the March 1, 2024 deadline. The Board Development Committee will be meeting with all the nominees over the next couple of weeks as part of our process in preparing for the CSCE Annual General Meeting (AGM) to be held in May. At the AGM, CSCE members will be electing three (3) new members to the Board of Directors. Why are we electing three (3) new members? The CSCE by-laws provide for a minimum of 5 and maximum of 9 members of the Board of Directors. In recent years, we have had an inconsistent turnover in the number of directors. Last year there was only a single vacancy; this year there are four (4) Board members whose terms are ending, namely Jon Halford, Matt Weening, Michelle Zuk, and Olugbenga Adebayo. To improve Board of Director transitions - including retaining Board member knowledge and assisting new members in getting up to speed as Directors, the Board is working towards achieving an annual turnover of three (3) Board members in each given year. Based on current and projected director terms, it will only take a couple cycles to get back to the turnover of three (3) Board members. This could be as early as 2026.
