Our CCS Students will help lead these children through puppet shows, face painting, reading bible stories, singing the worship songs that have been chosen for this event, helping with snack time, leading games, supervising children through different activities.

Here is what the trip will look like:

Friday, March 21:

1:00 pm - Get on the CCS Bus and drive to Lloydminster (we will stop in Sherwood Park for a pit stop and some treats for the road)

6:30 pm - Arrive at City Church in Lloydminster (the Ladies in the church will be providing all meals for us while we are there)

7:30 - 10:30 pm - Set up the church for SHINE ON event (set up carnival games, puppets, face painting station, worship area, Bible Lesson, snacks for children)

10:30 pm - Snack, devotionals and bedtime. (CCS students will bring their sleeping bags, pillows, thermarests, etc. as we will be sleeping at the church - girls in one area supervised by female chaperones and boys in a separate area of the church supervised by male chaperones)

1:00 - 4:30 pm - SHINE ON EVENT

5:00 - 6:00 pm - Clean up church

6:00 pm - SUPPER (supplied by Ladies at City Church)

7:00 pm - Worship night and games with City Church Youth Group.

10:30 pm- Snack, devotionals and bedtime

9:00 am - Breakfast at the church; pack up belongings
11:00 - 12:30 - Church - Celebration service to highlight Shine On!
1:00 pm- Load bus (CCS Students take bagged lunch on the bus provided by Ladies at City Church) & DEPART for home
** Pit stop in Sherwood Park
7:00 pm ARRIVE BACK AT CCS FOR PICK UP
