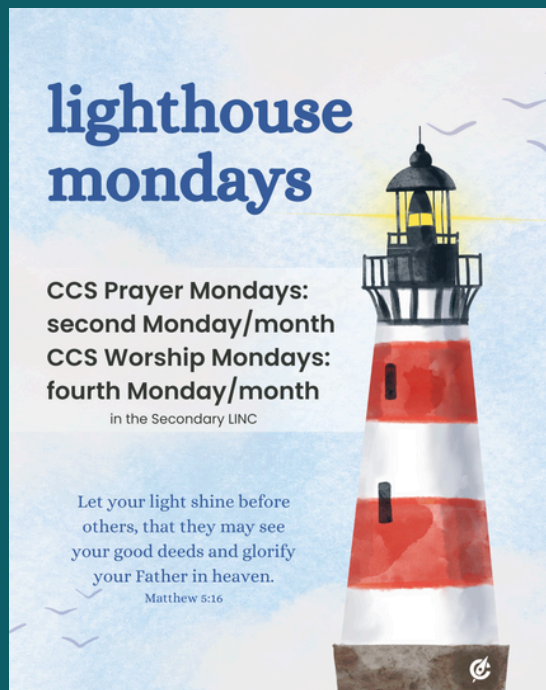
We are so grateful for so many amazing things that God is doing at CCS!
